Breathing out, peace and quiet

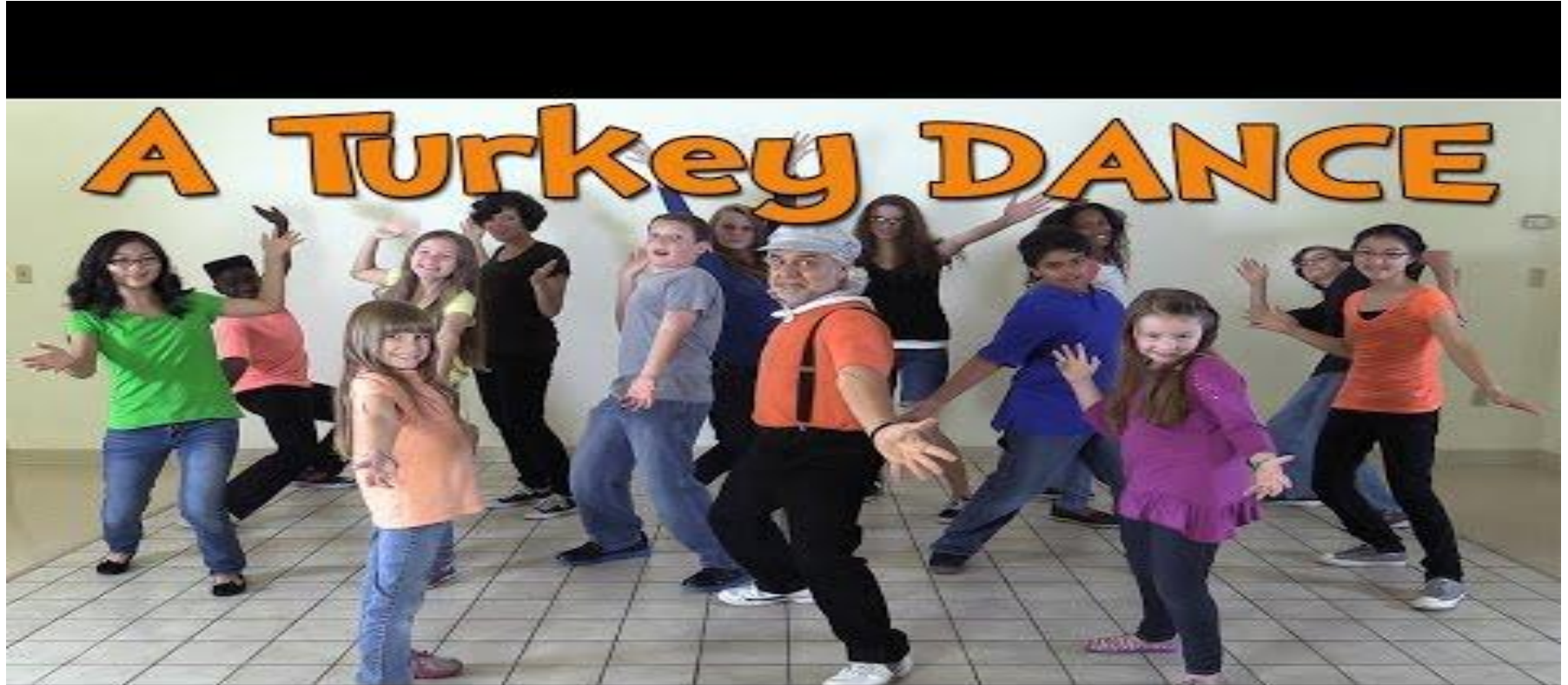
