**Breathing out, peace and quiet**

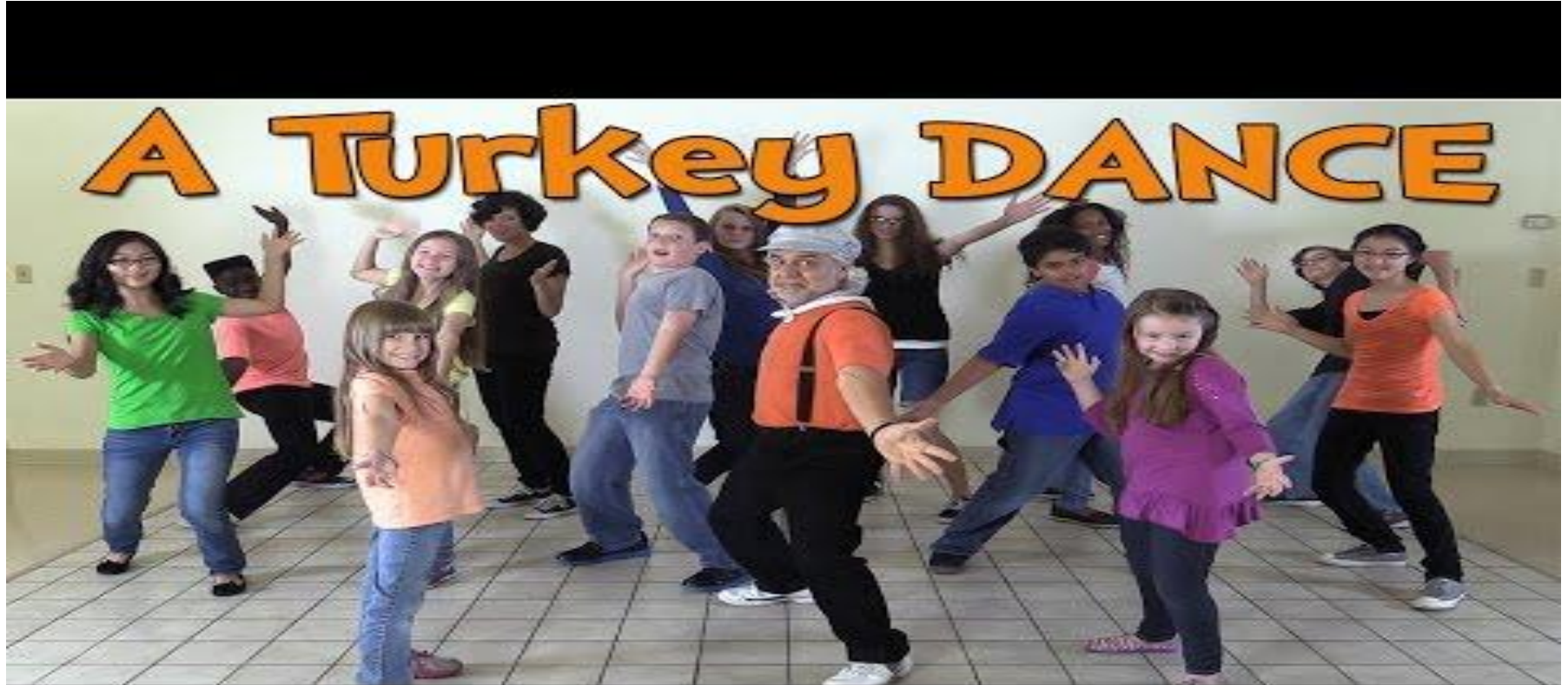
