Luke 10:25-37. The Story of the Good Samaritan

(25) One day an authority on the law stood up to put Jesus to the test. "Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to receive eternal life?" (26) "What is written in the Law?" Jesus replied, "How do you understand it?" (27) He answered, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

And, “Love your neighbor as you love yourself.” (28)
“You have answered correctly,” Jesus replied.”Do that
and you will live” (29) But the man wanted to make
himself look good. So he asked Jesus, “and who is my
neighbor?”(30) Jesus replied, “A man was going down
from Jerusalem to Jericho. Robbers attacked him
They stripped off his clothes and beat him. Then they
went away, leaving him almost dead.

(31) A priest happened to be going down the same road. When he saw the man, he passed on the other side of the street. (32) A Levite also came by. When he saw the man, he passed by on the other side of the street too. (33) But a Samaritan came to the place where the man was. When he saw the man, he felt sorry for him. (34) He went to him, poured olive oil and wine on his wounds and bandaged them. Then he put the man on his own donkey.

Then he put the man on his own donkey. He took him to an inn and took care of him.(35) The next day he took out two silver coins. He gave them to the owner of the Inn"Take care of him" he said. When I return , I will pay you back for any extra expenses you may have(36)
